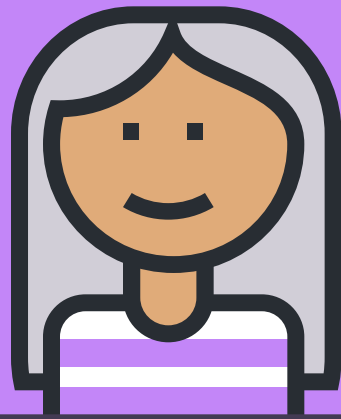

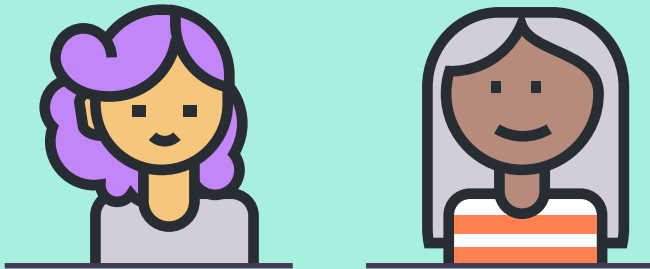



# Checklist before you submit a question



- Is “Your Question” in the form of a **QUESTION**? Did you provide **MORE DETAIL** on why you’re asking the question so the professionals answering can tailor their response to you?
- Did you make sure **NOT** to include any **PERSONAL INFORMATION**?
- Did you **#TAG** your question with relevant topics?
- Did you include a **geography**? (In what countries do professionals live that you would like to answer your question?)
